- 1. **Taylor, John** (1779-1863). Prospectus of a school of mines in Cornwall. [2], 21pp. London: A. Taylor, 1825 (colop.).
- 2. Lonsdale, William (1794-1871). Notes on the age of the limestones of south Devonshire. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society*, second series, 5 (1840). 721-738pp. Inscribed on the first leaf: "C. Stokes Esq. with the best regards of W.L."
- 3. **Hall, James** (1761-1832). On the consolidation of the strata of the earth. Offprint from *Transactions of the Royal Society of Edinburgh* (1825). [2], 16pp. First leaf inscribed: "Charles Stokes, Esq. With Capt. Hall's compts."
- 4. **Cumberland, George** (1754-1858). On the strata of Whorlbury Camp, in Somersetshire. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society* (1817). 6pp.
- 5. Witham, Henry (1779-1844). On the Lepidodendron Harcourtii. Offprint from *Transactions of the Natural History Society of Newcastle upon Tyne* (1832). 4pp. 2 hand-colored plates. First leaf inscribed: "To Mr. Stokes with the author's compts."
- 6. **Buckland, William** (1784-1856). On the Cycadeoideae, a family of fossil plants found in the oolite quarries of the Isle of Portland. Offprint(?) from *Transactions of the Geological Society*, second series, 2 (1828). 395-401, [3]pp. 4 plates.
- 7. **Bowerbank, James Scott** (1797-1877). On the siliceous bodies of the chalk, greensands, and oolites. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London* 6 (1841). 181-194, [2]pp. 2 plates. First leaf inscribed: "C. Stokes Esqr with the author's respects."
- Lea, Isaac (1792-1886). Notice of the oolitic formation in America, with descriptions of some of its organic remains. Offprint from *Transactions of the American Philosophical Society*, 2nd series, 7 (1840). 10pp. 3 plates. First leaf inscribed: "Chas. Stokes Esqr with the respects of the author."
- Thompson, John V. (1779-1847). Memoir on the Pentacrinus Europaeus: A recent species discovered in the cove of Cork, July 1, 1823. Cork: Printed for King and Ridings . . . , 1827. 12pp. 2 plates. Original front wrapper preserved, inscribed by British naturalist George Brettingham Sowerby (1788-1854): "Chas. Stokes Esqr with G. B. Sowerby's respects."
- 10. **Stutchbury, Samuel** (1798-1859). An account of the mode of growth of young corals of the genus Fungia. Offprint from *Transactions of the Linnean Society* 16 (1830). 493-498pp. Plate.
- 11. **Agassiz, Louis** (1807-73). Contributions to the natural history of the Acalephae of North America. Part 1. On the naked-eyed Medusae of the shores of Massachusetts, in their perfect state of development. Offprint from *Memoirs of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences*, new series, 4 (1850). 221-316pp. 8 plates. Original front wrapper preserved, inscribed: "Charles Stokes Esq from his friend L. - 12. **Broderip, William J.** (1789-1859). Description of some fossil Crustacea and Radiata, found at Lyme Regis, in Dorsetshire. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London*, 2nd series, 5 (1837). 171-174, [2]pp. Plate. First leaf inscribed: "C. Stokes Esqr with W. J. Broderip's kind regards."

- 13. Leach, William Elford (1791-1836). Observations on the genus Ocythoe of Rafinesque, with a description of a new species. Offprint from *Philosophical Transactions* (1817). 4pp. Plate.
- 14. **Bigsby, John J.** (1792-1881). Notes on the geography and geology of Lake Huron. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London* 6 (1824). [2], 175-209, [2]pp. 6 plates, folding frontispiece map.
- 15. Hays, Isaac (1796-1879). Description of a fragment of the head of a new fossil animal, discovered in a marl pit, near Moorestown, New Jersey. Offprint from *Transactions of the American Philosophical Society* 3 (1830). 471-477, [1]pp. Plate.
- 16. **Egerton, Philip Grey** (1806-81). A systematic and stratigraphical catalogue of the fossil fish in the cabinets of Lord Cole and Sir Philip Grey Egerton . . . London: Richard & John E. Taylor, 1837. [24]pp. Original printed front wrapper preserved, inscribed: "Charles Stokes Esq FGS from the author."
- 17. Whidbey, Joseph (1757-1833); William Clift (1775-1849). On some fossil bones discovered in caverns in the line-stone quarries of Oreston . . . To which is added, a description of the bones . . . Offprint from *Philosophical Transactions* (1823). 15pp. 7 plates. Original front wrapper preserved, inscribed: "Charles Stokes Esq. with Mr. Clift's respectful compliments."
- 18. **Buckland.** Geological account of a series of animal and vegetable remains and of rocks, collected by J. Crawfurd, Esq. on a voyage up the Irawadi to Ava, in 1826 and 1827. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London*, 2nd series, 2 (1828). 377-404pp.
- 19. **Pentland, Joseph Barclay** (1797-1873). Description of fossil remains of some animals from the north-east border of Bengal. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London*, 2nd series, 2 (1828). 393-394, [8]pp. 10 plates.
- 20. **Clift.** On the fossil remains of two new species of Mastodon, and of other vertebrate animals, found on the left bank of the Irawadi. Offprint from *Transactions of the Geological Society of London*, 2nd series, 2 (1828). 369-375, [6]pp. 9 plates. Original front wrapper preserved, inscribed on the verso: "To Charles Stokes Esq. F. R. S. with Mr. Clift's respectful regard."
- 21. **Tilesius von Tilenau, Wilhelm Gottlieb** (1769-1857). On the mammoth or fossil elephant found in the ice, at the mouth of the river Lena, in Siberia. London: Wm. Phillips, 1819. 15pp. Frontispiece plate.
- 22. Falconer, Hugh (1808-65); P. T. Cauley. Sivatherium giganteum, a new fossil ruminant genus from the valley of the Markanda, in the Sivalik branch of the sub-Himalayan mountains. Offprint from *Asiatick Researches, or Transactions of the Society Instituted in Bengal, for Inquiring into the History of Antiquities, the Arts, Sciences and Literature of Asia* 19 (1836). 24pp. Plate. First leaf inscribed: "To Charles Stokes Esq. from the authors." See above for more details.
- 23. Buckland. On the occurrence of the remains of elephants, and other quadrupeds, in the cliffs of frozen mud, in Eschscholtz Bay, within Beering's Strait, and in other distant parts of the shores of the Arctic seas. N.p., n.d. (1831?). First separate printing; also published as an appendix to F. W. Beechey's Narrative of a Voyage to the Pacific and Beering's Strait (1831). 20pp. 4 plates.
- 24. **Buckland.** On the adaptation of the structure of the sloths to their peculiar mode of life. Offprint from *Transactions of the Linnean Society of London* 17 (1834). 17-27pp.
